





Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:


1. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint filed by the Complainant Statewide Grievance Committee on May 25, 2005.
2. On, August 16, 2005, the local Grievance Panel for the New Haven Judicial District /G.A. 7 found probable cause that the Respondent had violated Rules 1.1, 1.3, 1.4, 8.4(4) of the Rules of Professional Conduct, and Practice Book § 2-32 (a)(1) arising from his representation of the Complainant in a matter involving the repossession of an automobile.
3. Respondent is the subject of a disciplinary action pending before the court, Docket No. CV-05-4013371, Disciplinary Counsel v. Kennedy, in the Judicial District of New Haven.
4. Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel and Respondent agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.


