

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

STIPULATION FOR PRESENTMENT

The undersigned hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. The above-captioned cases were instituted by grievance complaints filed with the Statewide Grievance Committee.
2. On May 18 and May 21 respectively, the Danbury Grievance Panel found probable cause on both files, finding numerous violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct as of record may appear.
3. The Chief Disciplinary Counsel has filed an application for interim suspension in the New Haven Judicial District on April 11, 2007 pursuant to Practice Book 2-42.
4. The parties to this agreement are desirous of consolidating the grievance cases with the pending interim suspension application in accordance with Practice Book 2-82(g).

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Respondent and the Chief Disciplinary Counsel agree to stipulate that an order of presentment may issue in Grievance Committee cases 07-0478 and 07-0482 for the purpose of consolidation of those cases with the pending interim suspension application.

2. Said order of presentment shall include both the rule violations found by the Danbury Grievance Panel on each file.

3. The proceedings before the New Haven Judicial District court shall consist of both the interim suspension application and a presentment on the pending grievance complaints combined with the additional issues contained in the two grievances already consolidated there.


