There was a vacancy on the reviewing committee at the time this agreement was filed. Accordingly, the matter was considered and decided by the undersigned.





AGREEMENT TO ORDER OF PRESENTMENT FOR CONSOLIDATION

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Keisha S. Gatison (hereinafter Respondent), juris number 424238, was admitted to the bar of the State of Connecticut on August 19, 2005.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2009 and is currently in good standing.
3. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint dated November 3, 2008.
4. On January 12, 2009, the Grievance Panel for the Judicial District of Danbury found probable cause that the Respondent had violated Rule 1.3 Diligence; 1.4(a)(1-5)(b); and Rule 8.4 (4) Misconduct of the Rules of Professional Conduct and Practice Book §§ 2-32 (a)(1).
5. The Respondent is already the subject of another disciplinary matter pending before the court, Disciplinary Counsel v. Keisha S. Gatison, Docket No. CV-08-4034809s, in the Judicial District of New Haven.
6. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.
7. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate that the order of presentment is requested for the purpose of consolidating all pending disciplinary matters before the Court.


