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

AGREEMENT TO ORDER OF PRESENTMENT FOR CONSOLIDATION

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Eugene Axelrod (hereinafter Respondent), juris number 304616, was duly admitted as a member of the bar of the State of Connecticut on February 27, 1986.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2009 and is currently in good standing.
3. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint dated December 11, 2008.
4. On February 23, 2009, the New Haven Judicial District and G.A. 7 Grievance Panel found probable cause that the Respondent had violated Rule 8.1(2) of the Rules of Professional Conduct and Practice Book §§ 2-32(a)(1).
5. On May 6, 2009, a reviewing committee of the Statewide Grievance Committee found additional probable cause that the Respondent violated Rules 1.15(b) and 8.4(2), (3), and (4), and Practice Book §2-27 (a) and (b).
6. The Respondent is already the subject of another disciplinary matter pending before the court, Disciplinary Counsel v. Axelrod, Docket No. CV 06-4023779-, in the Judicial District of New Haven.
7. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.
8. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate that the order of presentment is requested for the purpose of consolidating all pending disciplinary matters before the court.


