

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

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:


1. H. Jeffrey Beck (hereinafter Respondent), juris number 308959, was admitted to the bar of the State of Connecticut on December 8, 1988.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2010 and is currently in good standing.
3. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint dated June 3, 2010.
4. On July 26, 2010, the Fairfield Judicial District Grievance Panel found probable cause that the Respondent had violated Rule 1.15(b)(c) Safekeeping Property; of the Rules of Professional Conduct and Connecticut Practice Book §§ 2-27(a)(b)(c) and Section 2-28(h).
5. The Respondent is already the subject of another disciplinary matter pending before the court, Disciplinary Counsel v. H. Jeffrey Beck, Docket No. 10-6011820-S, in the Judicial District of Fairfield at Bridgeport.
6. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.
7. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate that the order of presentment is requested for the purpose of consolidating all pending disciplinary matters before the court.
