Reviewing committee member Attorney Thomas Maxwell was not available to review the matter. Accordingly, the matter was considered and decided by the undersigned.



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

AGREEMENT TO ORDER OF PRESENTMENT FOR CONSOLIDATION

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Ronald Piombino (hereinafter Respondent), juris number 302976, was admitted to the bar of the State of Connecticut on November 9, 1984.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2011 and is currently in good standing.
3. These matters were instituted by grievance complaints dated December 17, 2010, December 21, 2010 and December 21, 2011.
4. On April 18, 2011, the New Haven JD for GA 7 and the Towns of Branford, East Haven, Guilford, Madison & North Branford Grievance Panel found probable cause that the Respondent violated Rules 1.15(e), 1.15(f), 8.1(2) and 8.4(4) of the Rules of Professional Conduct.
5. The Respondent is already the subject of another disciplinary matter pending before the court, Disciplinary Counsel v. Ronald Piombino, Docket No. NNH CV 6008595S, in the Judicial District of New Haven.
6. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.
7. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate that the order of presentment is requested for the purpose of consolidating all pending disciplinary matters before the court.


WHEREFORE, this matter is submitted to the Statewide Grievance Committee for an order of presentment in accordance with Practice Book § 2-82(g).


