State of Connecticut v. Carlos Trujillo Scheduled to Begin November 1st

The murder trial of *State of Connecticut v. Carlos Trujillo* is scheduled to begin on Monday, Nov. 1, 2010 before Superior Court Judge Richard F. Comerford, Jr., in Courtroom 4A, at 10 a.m. in the Stamford-Norwalk Judicial District Courthouse at 123 Hoyt St., Stamford.

Logistics are as follows:

- Judge Comerford has approved requests from News 12 Connecticut and the Greenwich Time to videotape/photograph the trial respectively. Both organizations will serve as pool cameras. - Seating in the courtroom will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- On an as-needed basis, an overflow room will be in another courtroom on the 4th floor, with a monitor set up for viewing.
- Members of media organizations or the public may not use any electronic device in Courtroom 4A. This includes laptops. Tweeting is prohibited, per Judge Comerford.
- Laptops may be used in the overflow room, and tweeting is allowed from the overflow room.
