

Minutes of the Meeting

On Wednesday, December 7, 2016, the Code of Evidence Oversight Committee of the Supreme Court met in the Supreme Court courtroom from 2:10 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

1. The Honorable Judge Thomas A. Bishop called the meeting to order at 2:10 p.m.
2. The Committee unanimously approved the minutes of the meeting held on October 26, 2016.
3. The Honorable Judge Barbara B. Jongbloed reported on the status of the subcommittee's work on Article V, Presumptions, and anticipates a presentation of a draft to the Committee at the next meeting.

4. The Committee considered revised proposals to Article VII—Opinions and Expert Testimony, which were presented by the Honorable Judge Steven D. Ecker.

After discussion, the Committee unanimously voted to submit Article VII, attached hereto as Appendix A, to the Supreme Court for consideration.

5. The Committee considered proposals to Article VIII—Hearsay, which were presented by Judge Ecker and Attorney Adelman. During the presentation, Attorney Adelman proposed an

amendment to Sec. 8-3 (1). A discussion of such proposal will continue at the next meeting.

6. After discussion, the next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, January 25, 2017, in the Supreme Court courtroom at 2:00 p.m.

7. The meeting was adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
