recommendations contained in the report concerning establishment of an accounts receivable report. Attorney Blanchard reported that the Branch's Information Technology Division has been working on making such a report available.


- B.) Client Security Fund Account Summaries – Fiscal Year 2008 and Quarterly for April through June 2008.
