B.) Revision to Practice Book Section 2-65.

The committee took note of a recent change to Practice Book Section 2-65 approved by the judges of the superior court providing that attorneys must comply with Practice Book Section 2-70, the client security fund fee collection rule, before they can be considered in good standing in the Connecticut bar. The amendment to the rule is effective January 1, 2010.


C.) Article, "Fast Moves in the Nutmeg State", ABA Journal, August 2009
