I. OLD BUSINESS

A.) Minutes of Meeting, March 1, 2012

The minutes of the public meeting of March 1, 2012 were unanimously approved as drafted. Judge Lavine did not participate in the decision.

B.) Update on Proposals for Practice Book Rule Changes

Attorney Blanchard provided the committee with an update on several Practice Book rule changes that had been proposed by the committee which were forwarded to the Rules Committee of the Superior Court. Attorney Blanchard noted that the Rules Committee had determined that it would take no action on the proposed changes to Practice Book Sections 2-71(c)(1) and 2-75(h). The Rules Committee did, however, act favorably on proposed changes to Practice Book Sections 2-70(a) and 2-79, albeit with several modifications. The Rules Committee

version of the changes would reduce the client security fund fee to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00), but would specifically set the fee within the rule. The proposal for a reinstatement fee was also acted on favorably, with the amount of the reinstatement fee set at seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) within the rule.

The meeting adjourned at 2:13 p.m., with a meeting to consider matters exempt from F.O.I. and confidential pursuant to Practice Book Section 2-76 following immediately thereafter.
