I. OLD BUSINESS

A.) Minutes of Meeting, June 2, 2011

The minutes of the public meeting of June 2, 2011 were unanimously approved as drafted.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A.) Practice Book Sections 2-71, 2-75; Proposed Amendments

The committee considered drafts of proposed amendments to Practice Book Sections 2-71(c)(1) and 2-75(h) that were suggested at the committee's last meeting. The proposed amendment to section 2-71(c)(1)

would add a respondent attorney's in laws to the list of family members who are not eligible for reimbursement from the client security fund. The amendment to section 2-75(h) would remove the phrase "in processing the claim" from that subsection, thereby clarifying that attorney's fees incurred by a claimant in pursuing other remedies against an attorney would ordinarily not be reimbursable from the client security fund. After considering the proposed amendments, the committee unanimously voted to approve the same and directed Attorney Blanchard to forward the proposed amendments to the Rules Committee of the Superior Court for its consideration.

III. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 2:15 p.m., with a meeting to consider matters exempt from F.O.I. and confidential pursuant to Practice Book Section 2-76 following immediately thereafter.
