I. OLD BUSINESS

A.) Minutes of Meeting, May 26, 2022

II. NEW BUSINESS

A.) Proposed Revision to Practice Book § 2-79

The committee considered a proposal from Attorney Blanchard to recommend an amendment to Practice Book § 2-79 to the Rules Committee of the superior court for its consideration that would change the way notices of past due client security fund fees are sent to attorneys. Notices are sent by certified mail under the current rule. The proposed change would allow notices to be sent instead by first class mail and email. The intent of the change would be to make the notice provision of Practice Book § 2-79 consistent with new Practice Book § 2- 27B. The committee unanimously voted to forward the proposed amendment to the Rules Committee for its consideration.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:40 p.m., with a meeting to consider matters exempt from F.O.I and confidential pursuant to Practice Book § 2-76 following immediately thereafter.
