I. OLD BUSINESS

A.) Minutes of Meeting, July 14, 2011

II. NEW BUSINESS

A.) Assignment and Subrogation Agreement, Memorandum from Christopher G. Blanchard dated August 4, 2011

The committee unanimously approved changes to the assignment and subrogation agreement form proposed by Attorney Blanchard in his memorandum dated August 4, 2011.

- B.) Client Security Fund Fee; E-Mail from Judge Elliot Solomon dated July 6, 2011

The committee considered an e-mail dated July 6, 2011 from Judge Elliot Solomon to Judge Lavine regarding whether an additional fee should be charged to attorneys who have had their license to practice law in Connecticut suspended for failing to pay the client security fund fee at the time they pay their past due fee and seek reinstatement. After considering the issue, the committee directed Attorney Blanchard to draft a proposed change to the Practice Book rules regarding the imposition of a reinstatement fee for consideration by the committee at a future meeting.

- C.) Revision to Practice Book Section 2-16

The committee took note of an amendment to Practice Book Section 2-16 adopted by the judges of the superior court imposing the client security fund fee on attorneys admitted pro hac vice effective January 1, 2012.


- D.) Client Security Fund Account Summaries and Quarterly Report
