After a brutal assault (beaten with a pipe) in Dec 2021, I became a victim in Connecticut's "pro-offender" carousel of a justice system.

It wasn't until he was picked up for another incident that he was brought before the Judge.

Nearly 2 years later I'm still awaiting Justice.

I hope none of you ever become "a victim" because as I see no one has our back.
