Libbin on behalf of Judge Carroll to amend Sections 2-68, 2-70 and 2-77 concerning the Client Security Fund, to conform to the provisions of Public Act 16-26 which establishes an additional purpose of the fund, i.e., to "make grants-in-aid to the organization administering the program for the use of interest earned on lawyers' clients' funds accounts pursuant to section 51-81c, for the purpose of funding the delivery of legal services to the poor." ***(First time being considered.)***
