ORDER RE: NOTICE OF HEARING

It is hereby ordered that the State of Connecticut, by and through the Hartford State's Attorneys' office provide notice that on August 29, 2019 at 10 a.m., at 95 Washington Street, Hartford, CT 06106, the court will hold an evidentiary hearing on the merits of the State's application to exhume the unidentified remains of two adult females, killed in the Hartford circus fire on July 6, 1944 and buried under grave markers 2109 and 4512, in the Northwood Cemetery in Hartford Connecticut, as alleged in the State's application.

Notice shall be provided by certified mail return receipt requested, with return of such service made to the court, to:

1. The family and next of kin of Grace Dorothy (Smith) Fifield;
2. The City of Hartford; and
3. The Northwood Cemetery, Windsor Connecticut.


The State shall also provide notice of the hearing by publication to potential unknown family members or next of kin of parts unknown, claiming or who may claim rights or interest in the remains of grave markers 2109 and 4512, adverse to the State of Connecticut, by some proper officer, causing a true and attested copy of this Order to be published in the Hartford Courant once on or before August 8, 2019, and that return of such service be made to court.

Notice shall further be provided by Publication of this order on the Judicial Branch website. The clerk of the court will publish the above order on the webpage www.jud.ct.gov.
