The Connecticut Bar Examining Committee (CBEC) is pleased to offer computer-based testing (CBT) for the February 2017 Connecticut bar examination for all applicants who properly register within the above-referenced time period. The implementation of CBT is a direct result of the CBEC's continuing goal to enhance the bar admission process.

You will receive an email with further instructions on how to properly download the secure software when the registration period opens. The email will contain a user ID and password you must utilize to log onto this site, and begin the download process. Information on uploading your responses, taking your Mock exam, ExamSoft and the SofTest application can be found once you register. SofTest can be used on virtually any modern computer (i.e. purchases within the last 3-4 years). It is **not** possible to take secure exams through a virtual operating system such as Microsoft's Virtual Machine, Parallels, VMware, VMware Fusion or any other virtual operating system environment. Although SofTest can be installed and registered on virtual platforms, it will only be enabled for non-secure Practice Exams. Specific system requirements are noted below.
