

At its meeting on October 4, 2013, the Connecticut Bar Examining Committee adopted the following revisions to its Regulations. These revisions were published in the Connecticut Law Journal on November 12, 2013 and **become effective February 10, 2014**. Additions are signified by underlining; deletions are signified by strikeout.

ARTICLE V.

EXAMINATIONS

....

Art. V-2.

The examinations shall be in writing. The Committee shall provide pencils and pens. ~~Applicants shall bring pencils and pens.~~ The Committee may allow an applicant to utilize a portable electronic device capable of operating the designated software to answer Part A of the examination provided that the applicant follows the procedure set forth by the Committee for electing such option. Special circumstances may, with the prior written approval of the committee, warrant a waiver, in whole or in part, of the requirements of this Art. V-2.
