## Presenters

**Lauren Rowe** works with Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) as the National Director of Victim Services. Her responsibilities include developing and ensuring the implementation of the Victim Services model and strategy for the organization. She oversees MADD's strategic direction for serving more victims of substance impaired driving and expanding outreach to potential community referral sources. As well, she works to ensure victim/survivors receive the resources and assistance they need by developing and overseeing models for outreach, referrals, resources, training and case management.

**Dr. Robin Grant-Hall** is a trauma psychologist who has been in private practice in Glastonbury, Connecticut doing therapy, forensic evaluations, and supervision/trainings for over twenty five years. She began working with the Connecticut State Police (CSP) after the Newtown shooting tragedy offering trauma education, recommendations, and treatment. Since then, her professional life has taken a turn with the goal of educating law enforcement about the brain, stress, and cumulative stress overload. As a result of this work, she has developed a specialty in treating first responders. Her goal is to help law enforcement develop a better understanding about the impact of their work on their brains and ways to build resiliency in the face of escalating violence and trauma in our society.
