

E-Services Inbox for Supreme and Appellate Court Notices

Commencing Wednesday, November 15, 2017, notices in Supreme and Appellate Court matters will be provided electronically in the E-Services Inbox to attorneys and law firms. Self-represented parties that have an E-Services account and have filed an appellate electronic access form (JD-15-AC) will also be provided electronic notice in the E-Services Inbox.

Notices in appellate matters will continue to be provided to attorneys, law firms and self-represented parties on paper via U.S. Mail, in addition to the E-Services Inbox, until further notice. Dual notice will allow for litigants who have matters before the Supreme Court and the Appellate Court to become familiar with the Inbox and incorporate appellate electronic notices into their business processes.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2018, all self-represented parties will be required to submit an electronic access form unless exempt from the requirements of e-filing.
