The defendant's petition for certification to appeal from the Appellate Court, 221 Conn. App. 164 (AC 45281), is granted, limited to the following issues:

"1. Did the Appellate Court correctly determine that the defendant did not challenge the imposition of the standing criminal protective order on the ground that the trial court had failed to abide by the standard applicable to the imposition of such orders set forth in General Statutes § 53a-40e (a)?"

“Did the Appellate Court correctly conclude that the decedent’s former spouse and her daughter were not entitled to obtain the proceeds from the decedent’s life insurance policy in an interpleader action because the separation agreement requiring the decedent to designate them as beneficiaries contained a provision stating that the decedent’s failure to maintain the policy in accordance with the agreement’s provisions constituted a claim against the decedent’s estate?”
