Notice of Proposed Procedure from Connecticut Green Bank

C-PACE New Construction Pilot Program

In accordance with Section 1-121 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Connecticut Green Bank (the “Green Bank”) proposes to establish a new construction pilot program (the “Pilot”) within the framework of the existing C-PACE program authorized pursuant to Section 12-40g of the General Statutes of Connecticut (the “C-PACE Program”).

Summary of written procedures: The proposed Pilot within the C-PACE Program would establish the process by which financing may be made available, whether through Green Bank or C-PACE Program third-party capital providers, for qualifying property owners and developers seeking capital for high-performance commercial, industrial, institutional and multifamily housing new construction projects.

Statement of purpose: To adopt the Pilot within the C-PACE Program.
