Notice of Declaratory Ruling Proceeding

The Connecticut State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (“the Board”) will hold a hearing on August 19, 2021, for the purpose of issuing a declaratory ruling.

The subject of the declaratory ruling is as follows:

Whether the use of the Emsculpt Neo medical device is within the scope of practice for a licensed chiropractor in the State of Connecticut.

The hearing will be held by video conference, via Microsoft TEAMS, commencing at 9:30 a.m. The details for connecting to the hearing will be provided 3-5 days prior to the hearing by contacting the Department of Public Health, Public Health Hearing Office at phho.dph@ct.gov and will be posted to the Board’s webpage at <https://portal.ct.gov/DPH/Public-Health-Hearing-Office/State-Board-of-Chiropractic-Examiners/State-Board-of-Chiropractic-Examiners>

The Board has prepared this notice in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act (“UAPA”), Connecticut General Statute § 4-166 *et seq.*, and specifically Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4-176.

By law, a declaratory ruling constitutes a statement of agency law which is binding upon those who participate in the hearing, and may also be utilized by the Board, on a case by case basis, in future proceedings before it.
