Notice of Inactive Status of Attorney

Pursuant to Practice Book Section § 2-54, notice is hereby given that on September 12, 2022, in Docket Number HHD-CV 22-6157899, Monica L. Harper (Juris # 101746) of West Hartford, CT is placed on inactive status due to her incapacity to practice law until further order of this court.

The Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel shall immediately notify the Chief Clerks of all Judicial Districts and Probate Court Administration of the respondent's inactive status.

Attorney Laura Platt, with law offices in West Hartford, Connecticut Juris No. 427858, is hereby appointed as trustee pursuant to Practice Book § 2-64 and shall take such steps as are necessary to protect the interests of the clients of Attorney Monica Harper, including:

- a. inventory Attorney Harper's open files;
- b. notify all active clients of the respondent's inactive status;
- c. secure Attorney Harper's clients' funds accounts in TD Bank and Bank of America;
- d. make accountings and reports to the Court regarding IOLTA accounts; and
- e. secure and review the business mail of the Respondent.

The Trustee is not authorized to make any disbursements from said accounts without the prior approval of the Court.

The Trustee is not authorized to incur any reimbursable expenses without the prior approval of the Court.

The Respondent shall not deposit to, disburse any funds from, withdraw any funds from, or transfer any funds from, any clients' funds, IOLTA, or fiduciary accounts.

The Respondent shall comply with Practice Book § 2-47B (Restrictions on the Activities of Deactivated Attorneys) during her inactive status.

The respondent shall cooperate with the Trustee in all respects.

Notice of Suspension of Attorney

Pursuant to Practice Book Section § 2-54, notice is hereby given that on September 12, 2022, in Docket Number HHD-CV22-6158424-S, William W. Cobb, Juris No. 418432 of Saint Johnsbury, VT is suspended from the practice of law in Connecticut for a period fifteen (15) months, effective immediately.

The Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel shall immediately notify the Chief Clerks of all Judicial Districts and Probate Court Administration of the Respondent's suspension.

Respondent shall comply with Practice Book § 2-47B (Restrictions on the Activities of Deactivated Attorneys).

Should Respondent seek reinstatement to the Connecticut Bar, he must do so pursuant to Practice Book § 2-53 but he shall not be eligible to do so until he is eligible for reinstatement in the State of Vermont.

A Trustee will not be appointed as Respondent has not recently practiced law in Connecticut and has no clients nor an IOLTA account in the State of Connecticut.

Prior to reinstatement in Connecticut, Respondent shall satisfy any Connecticut Bar requirements and will be otherwise in good standing.

Pursuant to Connecticut Practice Book § 2-39, the court finds that the above order is commensurate with the order of the State of Vermont Professional Responsibility Board. So ordered.
