

## NOTICE

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### Notice of Suspension of Attorney

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Pursuant to Practice Book Section § 2-54, notice is hereby given that on September 20, 2022, in Docket Number HHD-CV22-6159039-S, Peter A. Saad, Jr., Juris No. 420995 of Riverhead, NY, is suspended from the practice of law in Connecticut as follows:

#### **COUNT 1 (Interim Suspension)**

That Peter A. Saad, Jr. (Juris No. 420995) poses a substantial threat of irreparable harm to his current and/or prospective clients and orders as follows:

The Respondent is placed on interim suspension from the practice of law, effective September 19, 2022, until further order of the court.

The Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel shall immediately notify the Chief Clerks of all Judicial Districts, Probate Administration, Worker's Compensation Commission and Office of the Public Defender Assigned Counsel Unit of the Respondent's suspension.

Within 72 hours of this order, the Respondent shall provide the Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel with:

- a. a written list of active/pending Connecticut files to include client's name, address, telephone number, email address, description of the matter, amount of retainer, paid (if any), itemization of all billing identifying any balance remaining, and whether there are any scheduled Connecticut court dates, statute of limitations, deadlines or other activity needing immediate attention.
- b. a list of all Connecticut client's funds accounts, IOLTA and/or fiduciary accounts, as well as NY IOLA accounts, maintained by Respondent, including the name of the banking institution and account number. For each account, the Respondent shall provide the last three months of bank statements including copies of the front and back of all cleared checks and all checks deposited, the general ledger, and all client ledgers to the Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel.
- c. Respondent's contact information during the period of suspension, including telephone number(s) and email address.

The Respondent shall fully comply with an audit of any IOLTA account by the Statewide Grievance Committee.

The Respondent shall comply with Practice Book § 2-47B (Restrictions on the Activities of Deactivated Attorneys).

The Respondent shall comply with Practice Book § 2-53 if the Respondent remains suspended for one (1) year or more.

The Respondent's failure to comply with this order shall be considered misconduct and may subject the Respondent to discipline.

**COUNT 2 (Reciprocal Discipline)**

On or about June 3, 2022, the Supreme Court of the State of New York Appellate Division: Second Judicial Department ordered Respondent immediately suspended from the practice of law pursuant to 22 NYCRR 1240.9(a)(1) and (3) for failure to comply with judicial subpoenas and failure to cooperate with lawful demands of the Grievance Committee for the Tenth Judicial District.

Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-39, the Respondent, Peter Saad, Jr. (Juris No. 420995) is placed on interim suspension from the practice of law, effective September 19, 2022, until further order of the court.

The Respondent shall comply with conditions as set forth in the Supreme Court of the State of New York Appellate Division: Second Judicial Department order, dated June 3, 2022.
