Notice of Disciplinary Order

DOCKET NO. NNH CV-20 6102022 S. SUPERIOR COURT OFFICE OF CHIEF DISCIPLINARY COUNSEL JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF vs. NEW HAVEN COREY A. HEIKS NOVEMBER 17, 2022.

ORDER

On the basis of the respondent's extensive history of discipline and his serious and repeated misconduct in this presentment, the court concludes that he is unfit to practice law and a substantial suspension is warranted as follows:

COUNT ONE

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for twelve (12) months and is to pay restitution in the amount of \$6000 to Joseph Rivera within six (6) months of this order. The respondent is to return the quad he received in lieu of fees to Joseph Rivera within thirty (30) days of this order.

COUNT TWO

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for three (3) months, concurrent with count one. The respondent is to pay restitution in the amount of \$2500 to Catherine Rivera within sixty (60) days of this order.

COUNT THREE

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for six (6) months consecutive to the suspension in count one and is to pay restitution to Burgos in the amount of \$3500 within six (6) months of this order.

COUNT FOUR

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for three (3) months, concurrent with count one. The respondent is to participate in the CBA fee dispute program regarding client Donald Gallo. If the respondent does not complete the mediation on or before March 1, 2023, he will pay restitution to Gallo in the amount of \$12,000 within one (1) year of this order.

COUNT SIX

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for six (6) months consecutive to the suspension in count one and is to pay restitution to Vanterpool in the amount of \$7000 within nine (9) months of this order.

COUNT SEVEN

The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for twelve (12) months consecutive to the suspension in count one. The respondent is to pay restitution in the amount of \$1500 to Frizell, Sr. within sixty (60) days of this order.

On the basis of the preceding findings, the court enters the following additional orders:

- 1) The respondent is suspended from the practice of law for a total effective term of three (3) years commencing upon entry of this order.
- 2) The respondent is to comply with Practice Book § 2-47b with respect to activities of deactivated attorneys.
- 3) An attorney trustee shall be appointed pursuant to the provisions of Practice Book § 2-64.
- 4) The respondent shall comply with Practice Book § 2-53 for reinstatement to the practice of law and may not be eligible for reinstatement until all court ordered restitution is paid in full. Proof of payment is to be provided to the Disciplinary Counsel.
