**Notice of Attorney Misconduct**

Pursuant to Practice Book Section § 2-54, notice is hereby given that on June 12, 2023, in Docket Number HHD-CV-23-6166927-S, Lowell Sidney, New York Juris #4307021, of Rockville Centre, NY shall immediately cease and desist from any legal advertisement or solicitation or legal representation in the State of Connecticut.

Effective immediately, Respondent may not negotiate, give legal advice, advertise legal services or otherwise give counsel in Connecticut or to any Connecticut residents concerning or with respect to their legal rights or responsibilities or with regard to any matter involving the application of legal principles to rights, duties, obligations, or liabilities of Connecticut residents or relating to Connecticut law. Respondent may not draft any legal document or agreement involving or affecting the legal rights of a Connecticut resident or engage in any conduct in a Connecticut matter as more fully described in Practice Book § 2-44A unless and until he is properly licensed to do so.

The Respondent shall provide restitution to Jennifer Crowhurst in the amount of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$10,000.00), within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order and by certified bank check only. The Respondent shall provide a copy of the certified bank check to the OCDC immediately upon issuing said check.

The Respondent shall be prohibited from applying for admission to the Connecticut Bar, in any capacity, for a period of twelve (12) months, effective upon the date of this Order.

Prior to applying for admission to the Connecticut Bar, the Respondent shall satisfy any and all Connecticut Bar requirements and shall be otherwise in good standing.
