Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-39, notice is hereby given that on August 14, 2023, in Docket Number HHD-CV23-6170947-S, Andrea Birnbaum Herbst, Juris 416213, of Suffern, NY, is hereby disbarred effective immediately.
