NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT REVISIONS TO THE BUSINESS TRAVEL AND RELATED EXPENSES POLICY

In accordance with sections 1-121 and 31-49h of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Connecticut Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Authority (“hereinafter the CT Paid Leave Authority”) intends to adopt revisions to their Business Travel and Related Expenses policy, which provides details related to payment and reimbursement of employees’ business travel and other related expenses by the CT Paid Leave Authority. The proposed revisions consist of updating the expenses that are reimbursable and non-reimbursable, adjusting limits to such reimbursable amounts, and the process for submitting such expenses to the CT Paid Leave Authority for reimbursement and approval.
